By registering, participants and staff accept that their personal data will be stored in the organizer's register and that names may be published as part of the event's activities, regardless of media format.

Registration

Registration

Registration must be completed and paid by June 30, 2025 via www.dragracing.eu. Drivers registering by April 21 will receive two festival tickets (value SEK 1,990) included in the entry fee. A receipt will be sent when payment is registered. Invoice payments may take 3–5 banking days. Bring the receipt to check-in. All teams must register at the main entrance, where payment and information will be verified.

Max/Minimum number of participants

Participation is limited to approximately 220 teams. The organizer reserves the right to increase the number if possible. If fewer than 4 drivers register in a class, they may be offered to compete in another class

Late Registration

Late registration is possible until July 24, 2025 if the maximum number is not reached. A late fee of SEK 1,000 applies.





Withdrawal

Withdrawals must be submitted via email to dragracing@mantorppark.com no later than the day before the competition. The entry fee is non-refundable unless otherwise agreed upon with the organizer.

Licenses

One-time or annual licenses can be purchased during registration at www.dragracing.eu or on race day.

Extra Team & Car Passes

Extra passes can be purchased during registration or upon arrival at Mantorp Park. Valid for the entire weekend.

Electricity

All power cables must have a valid event-specific power tag, obtained at check-in. The tag applies per outlet/team and does not include connection to accompanying vehicles. Lack of a tag may result in disqualification.

- 1 Phase 220V 10A: SEK 500

- 3 Phase 400V 16A: SEK 1,000

Race Cancellation

The race may be canceled. Notification will be provided at least 24 hours before inspection via Mantorp Park's website and social media.



Paddock Information

Arrival

Parking in the paddock is only allowed as directed by paddock staff. Private vehicles must be parked outside the area or in designated zones. Drilling or damaging the asphalt is strictly forbidden. A fee of SEK 1,000 is charged for minor holes and SEK 10,000 for major damage. This is considered compensation, not a penalty. Each team is responsible for its paddock area and must leave it clean upon departure. Walking speed applies throughout the paddock. Minors may not operate electric vehicles within the competition area.

Fuel

Refueling must be done with great caution. Refueling using open funnels is prohibited; hoses or similar must be used. Drivers are responsible for ensuring that no smoking occurs nearby during refueling.

Fire extinguishers

Each team must have an easily accessible fire extinguisher: minimum 6 kg powder, 6 liters foam, or 5 kg CO₂, placed at the front of their paddock area.

Environment

A tarp or environmental mat must be placed under the vehicle to avoid spills. Oil spills must be cleaned up immediately. Oil and other hazardous materials must be disposed of at the environmental station. A fine may be issued if these rules are not followed.

Class and Series Regulations

Technical Inspection

Inspection takes place at the designated location, except for certain classes that will instead be inspected at their paddock area. Information about which classes this applies to will be provided in a separate message emailed to all registered drivers before the event.

A map will be provided upon arrival.

Start numbers and Index/Dial-in

Start numbers and index/dial-in values must be displayed on the left side, front, and rear of the vehicle. Clear numbers are essential due to the limited field of view of the timing system.

Tow vehicles, Pit mopeds, Pushcars/Bikes, Kickbikes etc.

May only be operated by individuals with a driver's license or racing license. All motor vehicles used in the competition area must have valid insurance, including pit mopeds. Mantorp Park and SHRA Mantorp assume no responsibility for uninsured vehicles. All pushcars must be labeled with the race number of the associated competition vehicle

Advertising

Mantorp Park and SHRA Mantorp reserve the right to use registered drivers in race promotion and to place advertising on competition vehicles in accordance with Nitroz Motorsports' guidelines.

Team communication radios

Team radios are allowed in all classes. Radios must be of a type approved by the Swedish Post and Telecom Authority. If interference occurs with race management frequencies, the team must change channels.



Racing

General

The race management reserves the right to make changes to run order, ladder size, etc., without prior notice. All information, including qualifying lists and ladders, will be posted on the information board by the race office.

Fixed schedule

Some classes have fixed run times. Information will be provided upon arrival.

Qualification

Qualification will follow each class's specific rules.

Bracket

Pro Bracket will be used unless otherwise stated for a specific class.

Trophies

1st and 2nd place will receive trophies, with exceptions in certain classes (see series and class regulations). Trophies are only awarded if the competition is completed.

Award ceremony attendance

Personal attendance at the awards ceremony is mandatory to receive a trophy. Team apparel or other appropriate clothing is required. Trophies not collected during the ceremony will be forfeited to the organizer. The ceremony will be held immediately after the final races
